### **1. What are the eligibility criteria for B.Com?**

**Answer:** Candidates who have passed Class 12<sup>th</sup>/PUC/HSC from any stream are eligible for Admission to B.Com. Programmes.

**Answer:** Admission to the BBA course is generally done on the basis of marks secured in Class 12<sup>th</sup>/HSC/PUC and no separate Entrance Examination will be conducted for the same.
